Warm and comfy rooms to call your own

Our 83 bedrooms, separated into five communities, are bright, airy, comfortable and generously sized. The homely units are within the safety and security of the modern structure, which aids familiarity and the creation of a personal setting.

The units support orientation with careful consideration of colour, light and furnishing based on current research into caring environments.

All bedrooms have a private en-suite complete with a sink, toilet and a walk-in shower or wet room. Residents are encouraged to bring along some personal possessions so that they can really make their rooms their own.

Every unit has its own communal facilities, including spacious movement areas, lounge and dining areas, kitchens and assisted bathing facilities. Throughout Tŷ Penrhos, there are high standards of insulation and a rain water harvesting system to make the building energy efficient and environmentally friendly.

Safe outdoor spaces to explore and enjoy

There are multiple private garden areas that get lots of sunlight and provide regular opportunities for gardening and social activities. Everybody can benefit from spending time outside in the fresh air without worrying about their safety or privacy.

Staying in the community

Our residents love the fact that there is a local public house and a supermarket within walking distance from Tŷ Penrhos (supported by our team based on individual needs). It gives them a chance to stretch their legs, not to mention the opportunity to sit back with their favourite drink, enjoy a pub lunch or simply relax in the company of others.

Tŷ Penrhos has communal spaces where residents can take part in hobbies, catch up over cups of tea and spend quality time with their friends and family.

- A secure door entry system
- · CCTV cameras to the external environment
- A 24-hour nurse call system
- A full fire alarm system incorporating all safety features
- Two large lifts
- Safety restrictors on all windows
- Well-lit car parking for visitors
- Specialist assisted rise and fall baths
- Hearing loops fitted in all our lounge and dining areas
- Enclosed private garden areas

We don't have set visiting times, so our residents are able to have visits from friends and family as and when they like. To encourage regular visits, relatives have the opportunity to purchase a key fob so that they can pop by as they please.

Tŷ Penrhos is located in Caerphilly, a large town at the southern end of the Rhymney Valley. It benefits from being close to local amenities, including shops, restaurants, cafés, green spaces, heritage sites and the famous Caerphilly Castle. Once a year, there's The Big Cheese, a wonderful family-friendly celebration of Welsh food and drink around the castle grounds. There is a train station in the town with regular services to major cities.
